

Fire Marshalling - (practical use of extinguishers, using external fire rig, provided separately)

Who is the course Aimed At?

This course is for any person tasked with providing the role of a Fire Marshal in company managed premises.

Course duration

2 hours

Objectives

To learn how to understand the responsibilities, practical and administrative methods of reducing risk, equipment in use and managing persons on site.

Training Course Content

- Identifying the responsibilities of a Fire Marshal / Nominated Officer
- Identifying detection and warning systems in place (site specific)
- Understand the meaning of 'Means of Escape'
- Understanding general fire precautions and fire prevention
- Recognising the requirement for fire drills
- Recognising the requirements of any disabled or mobility impaired persons (PEEPs)
- Identifying fire-fighting equipment in place
- Practical implications of using fire-fighting equipment (classroom teaching)

All training is customized to the client and includes a scoping session and use of company related documents, e.g. risk assessments/method statement, if required.
